## QUALIFICATIONS

Program participants must be 21 years of age and be able to pass a DOT physical, background check, and drug screening. Participants must be able to read, speak, and comprehend the English language sufficiently to meet the Department of Transportation regulations. Participants may need to be available for some evening on-the-road training.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Classes begin every 4 weeks at a cost of \$3,500 including some additional fees. For more information about upcoming start dates, application to the program, and possible funding options, contact Vicki Shadell by phone at 501-977-2132 or by email at [shadellv@uaccm.edu](mailto:shadellv@uaccm.edu).

Receive 160 hours of training over the course of 4 weeks.

Get guided hands-on experience with a big rig, including training in driving, hooking up, backing, and pre-trip and post-trip inspections.

Prepare to pass both the written and skills exams necessary to obtain a Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL).
